How did you decide on the Mediterranean as the next destination to explore with *Food & Wine*?

The Mediterranean sits at a major cultural crossroads, and that makes it an exciting culinary region. The food and wine traditions here can be traced back to ancient civilizations and their historical trade for spices and produce throughout modern-day Europe, Asia, and Africa. We plan to capture these rich traditions in daily meals and special experiences that leverage our connections to local purveyors, as well as the special wine list curated by *Food & Wine*.

What ingredients are Mediterranean dishes derived from, and what makes the cuisine so widely celebrated?

Mediterranean cuisine is one of traditions and rituals, born from families cooking together, sharing

Tell us about the region’s wines. What are their notable characteristics?

The climate creates perfect conditions for grape cultivation, allowing many varieties to thrive, which leads to diverse styles of wine. Local winemakers have always maintained a deep respect for tradition and terroir, while also embracing modern tastes and technologies; this harmony of culture and viticulture makes the wines incredibly appealing.

Can you tease any new culinary experiences featured on our voyages in the region?

The experiences will center on traditional culinary techniques, paired with the preeminent wines of the region. Expect to explore flavors directly alongside local experts during visits to little-known places that exemplify the region’s enduring culinary traditions.



Choosing Your Mediterranean Adventure

For the first time since 2017, National Geographic Orion is sailing the Mediterranean, offering voyages that marry active exploration with cultural discovery. For our return to this storied region, the itineraries are infused with an in-depth discovery of regional wines selected by Food & Wine's Executive Wine Editor, Ray Isle—but beyond the culinary delights, there is more to explore. Here are some highlights from each voyage to help you decide which of our new Mediterranean expeditions is the best fit for your interests.

Greek Isles Odyssey: Mythology, History, and Cerulean Seas | 8 Days

With epic sunsets, fresh seafood, and sun-soaked beaches, the Greek Isles beg to be explored by sea. On a voyage that whisks you from one idyllic island to the next, explore popular stops like Santorini, along with tranquil islands of your Grecian dreams. Hear the mythology and history woven across the Cyclades, and discover the unique cultural traditions that thrive on each isle.

Best for: Greek mythology, archaeology, iconic scenery



Crossroads of the Ancient World: Exploring Greece and Turkey | 11 Days

Combine your exploration of the Greek Isles with a taste of Turkey on a voyage through lands steeped in history and mythology. Uncover an archaeological treasure trove, where the columned temples of the Greeks and Romans rub shoulders with Ottoman minarets and mosaics. Tap into the region's age-old traditions during a pottery demonstration, Turkish coffee ceremony, and mesmerizing performance by whirling dervishes.

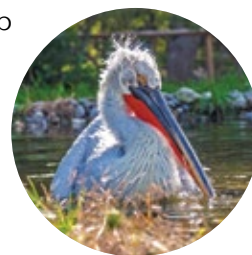

The eastern Adriatic is bordered by an enchanting patchwork of colorful ports and hilltop forts that rivals any riviera in Europe. The voyage also features a special treat for birders: Albania's Divjakë-Karavasta National Park, home to over 200 avian species.

Cultural treasures await as well: delve into centuries-old traditions such as oystering and olive oil production in enchanting medieval cities like Dubrovnik, Hvar, and Kotor in nearby Montenegro.

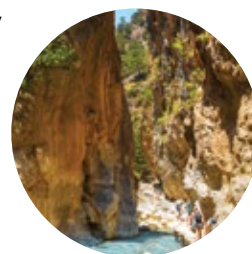
