Following the 2025 summer season in the Mediterranean, on the eve of her 95th birthday, the historic tall ship *Sea Cloud* will undergo extensive updates and a meticulous restoration. Next year, take your final opportunity to sail *Sea Cloud* in timeless places like the Caribbean, Greece, and Croatia before she sails into dry dock for the foreseeable future.



New Caribbean Voyages Aboard Sea Cloud II

We are delighted to announce that we are expanding our explorations in the Caribbean with the addition of two new expeditions aboard Sea Cloud II: Antigua to the BVIs: Hidden Cays & Azure Seas and Sailing St. Lucia, Dominica & Beyond. These voyages invite you to explore an array of intriguing new island offerings, from the sparkling white sands of Anguilla to the lush forests of the British Virgin Islands and the emerald mountains of St. Kitts.

Get a fresh perspective on tropical paradise as we sail from one idyllic isle to the next, going ashore to snorkel in shimmering turquoise coves, kayak through tangles of mangrove forest, and hike volcanic slopes draped in a thousand shades of green. Along the way, spot a rainbow of Caribbean wildlife, from red-billed tropicbirds to green sea turtles. We'll also delve into vibrant Caribbean cultures that blend the customs of indigenous peoples with those of buccaneers and brigands, sailors and settlers, as we explore military fortresses, manor houses, batik workshops, and much more.







The Art of Sailing

One of the great joys of traveling aboard a traditional tall ship is witnessing the theater of her spirited crew as they raise and lower the sails by hand en route to our next destination. Whether you are just beginning your journey or have already seen the process dozens of times, it is always thrilling to watch acrobatic sailors climb the rigging, loosen the heavy cloth, and haul the lines in from the deck–performing a grand choreography that never ceases to mesmerize. On both *Sea Cloud* and *Sea Cloud II*, nothing happens at the push of a button–often, almost a full hour passes before all the sails can catch the wind.

The genuine camaraderie between captain and crew allows them to work in concert. Many of the sailors have been with the Sea Cloud fleet for decades, and for them, the square-rigger is home. As a guest on board these special ships, you become part of their family. The crew is eager to show you the art of their daily work among the ropes, winches, and cleats. And the captain's bridge is always open for an in-depth look at the



intricacies of turn-of-the-century navigation, before steamships dominated global waters.

While at sea, the ship engines are only used when necessary, allowing you to become fully immersed in a tranquil sailing experience. Settle into a deck chair with a book and spend long hours under sail, enjoying balmy sea breezes and soaking in the beauty of your maritime surroundings.

A legend of both her time and today, the historic square-rigger *Sea Cloud* whisks travelers away to the golden age of yachting, when the billowing sails of majestic windjammers graced ports around the globe. Built in 1931 for the heiress

Marjorie Merriweather Post, *Sea Cloud* is the last of the private tall ships and the most beautiful vessel wherever she sails, turning heads from the Caribbean to the Mediterranean.

Sea Cloud's gleaming wooden masts carry 30 sails, which are raised by hand as you venture out to sea. Settle into the comfortable banquette of the ship's "blue lagoon" and take in the theater of sailors climbing the rigging and catching the wind. The covered lido bar is a relaxing spot for a refreshing drink, and the captain's open-bridge policy invites guests to take an up-close look at the intricacies of sailing this traditional four-masted barque.

The ship interiors are no less alluring, with every detail– from the marble fireplaces to the French antiques– reflecting the extravagant charms of American royalty. Marjorie Merriweather Post was instrumental in designing the staterooms and shared spaces, many of which are outfitted with antiques and period-style furnishing. The 30 outside-facing cabins are uniquely decorated and have hosted illustrious guests from princes to presidents, and cabinet members to celebrities. No accommodations are more lavishly appointed than the two owners' suites: a rich, woodpaneled sanctuary that belonged to Post's financier husband, E.F. Hutton, and the heiress' all-white dream, emanating superb Louis XVI style, gold fittings and all.

With modern amenities and exquisite style, Sea Cloud II combines the spaciousness of a contemporary vessel with the grace and elegance of a classic square-rigger.


Expansive outdoor decks and viewing areas tempt guests to soak in Mediterranean and Caribbean scenery and savor the romance of traveling under billowing sail. Al fresco dining–accompanied by a pianist and fresh sea air–is offered on the lido deck, where conversation flows and camaraderie comes naturally. While the ship's lavish indoor spaces, like a sizable dining room and lounge, are suitable for formality, there's a lighthearted delight to enjoying them in casual dress. Guests can also take advantage of a cozy library stocked with books on the region and a spa that offers a sauna, fitness area, and massage therapy.

From elegant bathrooms and silk-upholstered furnishings to flat-screen televisions and minibars,



each of the 44 outward-facing cabins on *Sea Cloud II* is outfitted with luxurious and modernized amenities. Sleep like royalty amid mahogany and marble and wake up to bedside views of sapphire seas or the colorful harbor of a quaint fishing village.

Spend days ashore exploring storied destinations from Greece to Croatia and beyond. Or simply settle into a lounger on deck and immerse yourself in the splendor of a bygone era, enjoying balmy breezes and the spectacle of the *Sea Cloud II* crew working the rigging.

Must-See Sights, Hidden Delights

When you travel aboard a Sea Cloud ship with Lindblad Expeditions-National Geographic, you explore on expertly crafted itineraries that take you to storied sites and secret gems far from the crowds. Discover iconic landmarks, from the ancient stadium at Olympia to the Doric temples of Sicily, and enjoy exclusive experiences, like a Croatian peka lunch at a family-owned winery in Vis.

See Sicily's Classical Icons

Take in magnificent Greco-Roman ruins in the Valley of the Temples, a UNESCO World Heritage site where grand rows of Doric columns stand stunningly intact, marking devotional sites for Zeus, Heracles, and other gods of ancient mythology.



Delve into the Rich Culture of Dominica

Explore Dominica, the "nature island of the Caribbean," alongside local women whose knowledge of the rainforest's flora and fauna is deeply intertwined with local cultural expressions like music, art, and cuisine.

Let the Games Begin in Olympia

Witness the birthplace of the ancient Olympic Games, which pitted athletes from rival Greek city-states against one another in competitions such as boxing and chariot racing.



Explore this UNESCO World Heritage site and visit the impressive Archaeological Museum nearby.

Visit the Crown Jewel of Croatia

Vis was a Yugoslav military base during World War II and only opened to travelers in the 1990s. Tourism has been slow to take hold on this sleepy isle, where we will tour the enchanting fishing town of Komiža and



enjoy a traditional *peka* lunch at a family winery.

Encounter Anguilla's Colorful Wildlife

This pristine Caribbean isle harbors a rainbow of species above and beneath the waves. Snorkel with swirls of kaleidoscopic fish, like yellow goatfish and blue-hued



angelfish, and set out on birding walks to spot tropical king birds and pearly-eyed thrashers.

Step Back in Time in Sifnos

Sifnos is what Santorini once was–a Grecian dream of empty turquoise coves and sleepy olive groves. Wander white-washed Kastro to the Church of the Seven Martyrs, a lone blue-domed chapel dramatically crowning the cliffside: then cap off the



lone blue-domed chapel dramatically crowning the cliffside; then cap off the day with a dip in the waters beneath town.

Dine in a Private Sicilian Castle

Sit down to a lunch of Sicilian specialties at the Castello degli Schiavi–a beautiful Baroque villa that provided the backdrop for some of the most pivotal scenes in *The Godfather* movies. Guests will also be invited to the wine cellar for a private tasting of local bottles.



Explore Caribbean Military Architecture

Amid the emerald mountains of St. Kitts, wander the bastions, barracks, citadels, and cisterns of Brimstone Hill Fortress, a UNESCO World Heritage site commissioned by the British in 1690 and built by slaves over the course of the following century.







Built in 1931 by Wall Street businessman E. F. Hutton for his wife, Marjorie Merriweather Post, *Sea Cloud* carries 30 sails measuring a total of 32,000 square feet. *Sea Cloud*, the last of the private tall ships, is the destination, regardless of which destination she explores. She spends the winter sailing the trade winds of the Caribbean and heads to the Mediterranean in the summer.


PUBLIC AREAS: The covered Lido Bar is a superb place to congregate and enjoy the outdoors. The open-air "Blue Lagoon" is a wonderful place to relax. There is a sumptuous lounge and guests are welcome on the Bridge to learn how *Sea Cloud* is navigated and sailed.

MEALS: Served in single seatings and in a casual setting, meals focus on local and Continental cuisine. Beer, wine, cocktails, and spirits are on us. We are also pleased to offer a selection of super premium wines and liquors, available for purchase. Refreshments are always available.

CABINS: The Main Deck cabins have antique and period-style furniture. These cabins are the ship's original cabins, including the owner's suites originally occupied by E.F. Hutton and Marjorie Merriweather Post. Cabins on the Promenade and Captain's Decks have modern, stylish, comfortable furniture.





CATEGORY 3: #32-37 Cabins have two single beds (which can be pushed together to make a queen-size bed, with one side against the wall), a window and shower.

CATEGORY 4: #30-31 Cabins have a queen-size bed, a forward-facing window and shower.


ORIGINAL/DELUXE CATEGORY B: Original/deluxe cabins, #5, 6, 9, 10 Located on the Main Deck, these large cabins, originally occupied by guests (and the nannies, #9-10) of the owner, have a mix of bed types, decorative motifs, bathrooms with tub or shower. All have portholes.

ORIGINAL/DELUXE CATEGORY A: Original/deluxe cabins, #3, 4, 7, 8 Located on the Main Deck, these very large cabins, originally occupied by guests of the owner, have a mix of bed types, decorative motifs, bathrooms with bathtubs. All have portholes.

OWNER'S SUITES: Original owner's suites #1-2 These incomparable suites were occupied by Marjorie Merriweather Post (#1) and E.F. Hutton (#2). They have king-size beds and grand marble bathrooms with bathtubs. Both suites have portholes.

CATEGORY 1 SOLO: #16-17 Upper and lower single beds, a porthole and shower.


